Kayaking

Marco Polo Travel suggests kayaking on the Bu Be Lakes, in the northeast of Vietnam.

They are three linked lakes supplied by three rivers, in an area of 500 hectares. The lakes belong to Bu Be national park.

The lakes are not crowded by cafes, hotels and restaurants. There is a river run by the national-park management. Women in dug-out-logs. There is a lot of noise and exhaust from the locals' outboard-motoboots, their main means of transportation.

Marco Polo Travel provides inflatable kayaks and charges \$300 a person for a five-day tour, including food, accommodations, and guide.

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Getting there:

Bu Be is in Bac Kan Province and 240km northeast of Hanoi, or 55km from Bac Kan. It is accessible by car.
